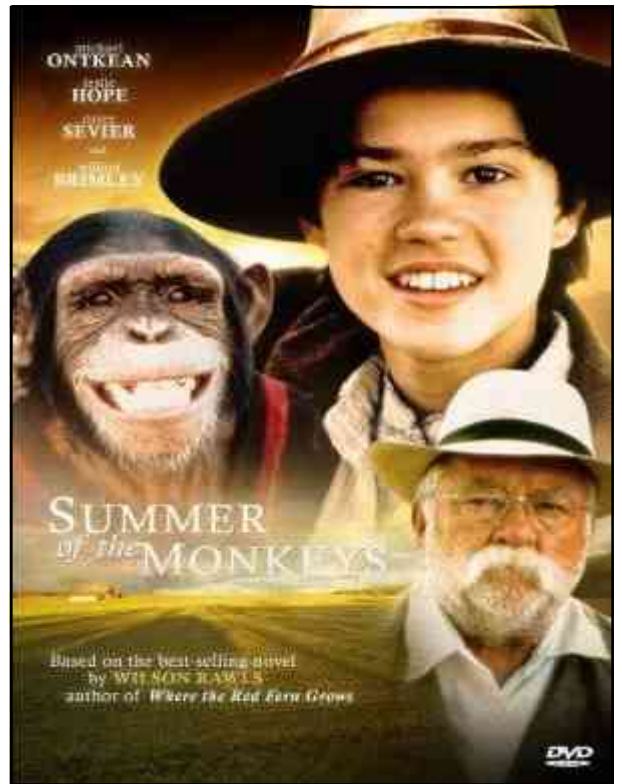

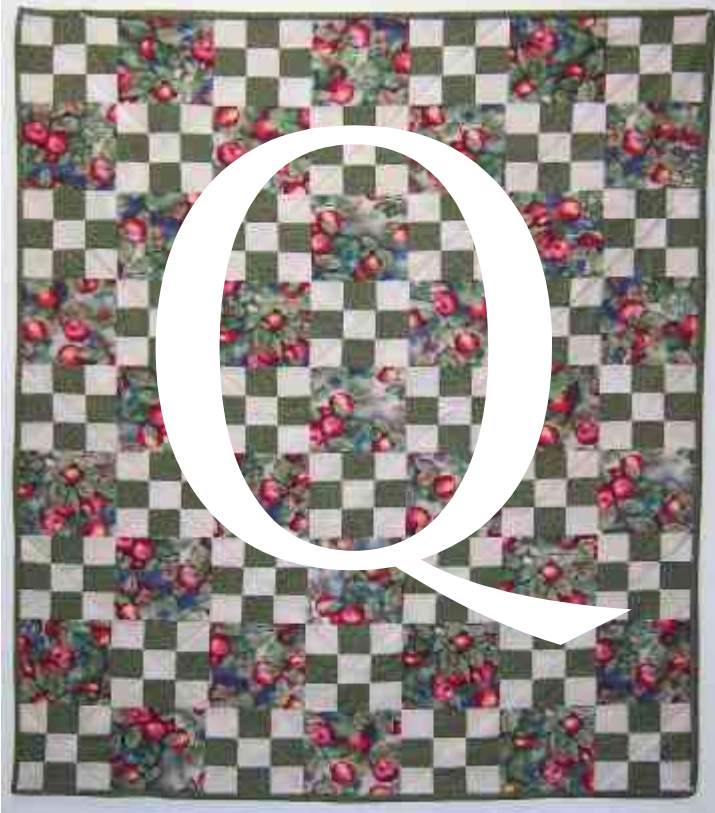

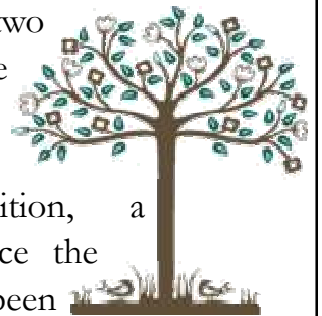


## YOUTH/MOUNTAIN T.O.P

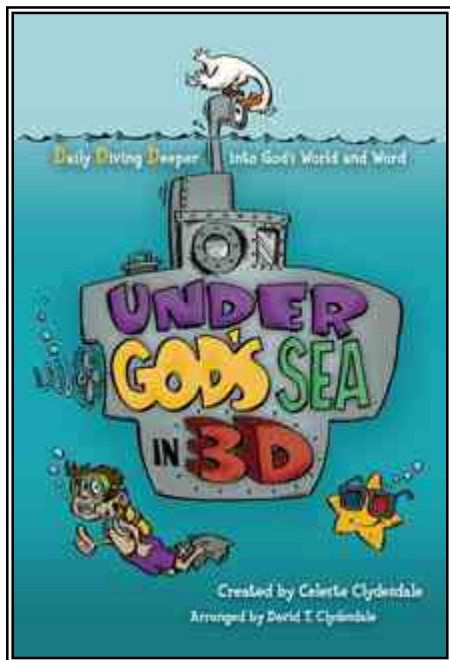

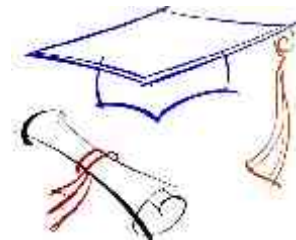
