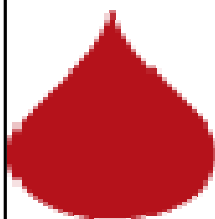
Florida Blood Center's (FBC) mission is to "...provide a safe, reliable, and affordable blood supply to our community by stewarding the donor's gift of life."

From the moment a donor gives blood to the time a patient needs it, FBC is dedicated to excellence in all phases of their operation. Donors are the most important people in this endeavor, and FBC is committed to their safety, comfort and convenience before, during and after the donation process. Donors are literally the life blood of the organization and FBC could not meet the need of our communities without them.

FBC also supports advanced scientific research into the prevention of disease, and is a partner with leading research institutes on cutting-edge solutions to the most pressing health problems of our time.

When you donate blood, you are making an immediate contribution to the health and welfare of our community. After it is collected, your blood is kept at one of FBC's regional laboratories while a sample is tested and screened at state-of-the-art medical facilities in Orlando. After testing, the results are shared electronically with the regional lab, which then delivers your donation directly to patients in need at hospitals in the community. Your donation is usually available to patients within 48 hours after it is collected.

FBC's "Big Red Bus" will be at Asbury on Sunday, November 20 from 8:00 am until 1:00 pm. You can make an appointment online at www.fbcdonor.org, or by calling 1-888-9-DONATE. Be sure to eat a good breakfast before you donate. Each donor will receive a free movie ticket from Fandango.

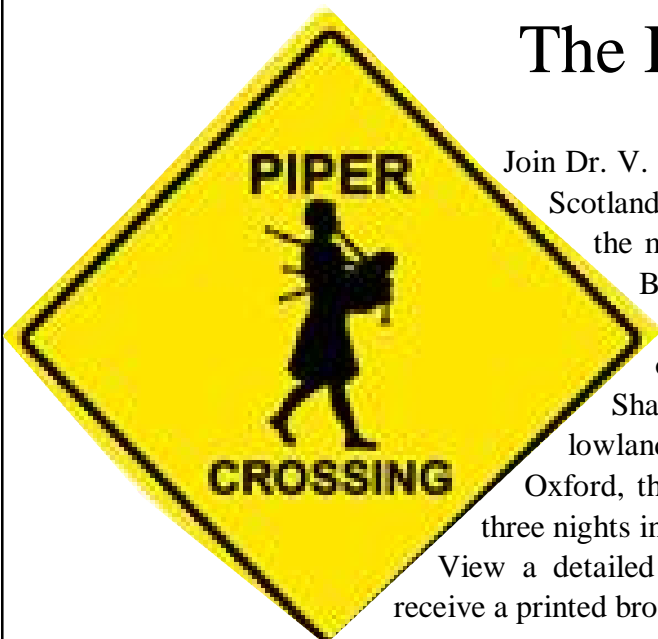

GENERAL CONFERENCE 2012 SEEKING VOLUNTEERS

The Florida Conference will host the **2012 General Conference**, which will be held at the **Tampa Convention Center**. The 11 day event is slated for **April 24 through May 4, 2012**. Nine hundred eighty-eight delegates from all over the world will be in Tampa representing their conferences. In addition to delegates, there will be 5,000 to 6,000 observers and guests attending the General Conference. As the host conference, our role is to provide hospitality to delegates and visitors during General Conference.

Over 1,000 volunteers will be needed to offer a warm welcome to delegates from around the world.

Under the leadership of Reverend James Harnish, the Florida Hospitality Team has been working for several years in preparation for this event, and asks for everyone's support in meeting the **huge need for volunteers**.

COUPON MINISTRY

Thanks very much to those who have donated coupons to assist this ministry !! The following information is provided to clarify the purpose and the progress of our gift to God's children.

The **PURPOSE** is to help feed those in need. The **PROGRESS** depends on the amount of coupons we collect.

Each week I search for items on sale, then I check the coupons to match those items. In order to purchase those items in bulk, I decided (with permission from the church office) to raise money by selling soup. From the proceeds of the soup, I buy what is needed to make soup for the following week. Then I use the money that is left to shop for sale items.

Just to clarify, I don't buy it just because it's on sale and I have a coupon, it has to be a GREAT sale – along with the coupon – in order to get the most for the money. For example, one container of soup is sold for \$5.00. From the sale of just one container, I was able to purchase 62 boxes of pasta and 18 jars of peanut butter....AND....I had change left !

Obviously that was the result of collecting LOTS of coupons. Now I'm hoping to find sauces to go along with the pasta and jelly for the peanut butter. This way we will be supplying a whole meal !

It doesn't stop there !! I will also purchase toiletries, household cleaning supplies, laundry detergent, etc., when I have the coupons and these items are on sale. When the deal is too good to resist, I will purchase ANYTHING to help a family in need.

Please continue to support this ministry by placing coupons in the box provided in the hallway between the church work room and the doors to the parlor. There will also be a box provided in the Fellowship Hall once the renovations are complete.

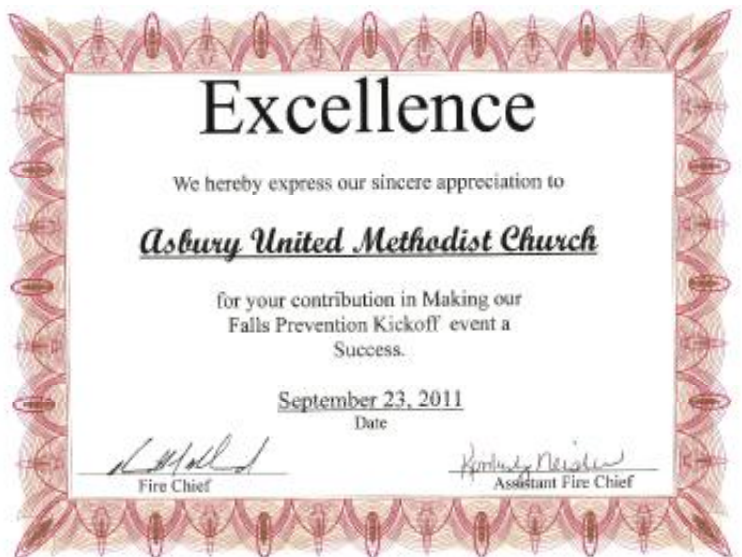
